LADIES AUXILIARY INVITED TO GOVERNOR'S HOME JAN 27 2009

There will be no luncheon this month. We will meet at the Governor's home on January 27, 2009 at 1:15 PM, on Maryland Avenue at North Parkview Avenue in Bexley. On-street parking is available on Maryland, Parkview and other side streets. Guests enter the property from Maryland Avenue. Linda Meadows will check the group in with the Ohio Highway Patrol in the Carriage House upon arrival.

An alphabetized list of tour guests must be submitted for security purposes at least a week before the scheduled tour. Each guest must provide photo identification and be on the alphabetized guest list for admittance. **Purses, backpacks and bags must be left in your vehicle.**

The tour is one hour of standing and walking. For security reasons, **tour guests must stay with their group at all times. Visitors who are unable to remain standing will be asked to return to their bus or car, as visitors cannot be unescorted on Residence grounds.**

Cameras are welcome; however, photos of the works of art are prohibited. Cell phones must be turned off during the tour. Although your tour is free, donations to the Friends of the Ohio Governor's Residence and Heritage Garden are welcome.

NEW AUTO LICENCE PLATE HONORS MIL PERS WHO HAVE SERVED IN COMBAT ZONES

(COLUMBUS)– A new specialty license plate is now available through the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV).

"We are proud to honor those who have served our country, and are pleased to announce that we can offer this distinction for those who have served in combat zones," said Ohio Department of Public Safety Director Henry Guzmán.

House Bill 372 gave the BMV the authority to place the battle star display on combat or military license plates. There is no additional cost other than the usual registration fees. The BMV began offering the plate, which has 40 different distinctions, in late September.

"Through our partnership with the Ohio legislature, the BMV now has ten categories of military plates with more than ninety varieties of plates for those who have served or are serving our country, in addition to plates for families of military service people to honor loved ones," said BMV Registrar Mike Rankin. "We are pleased to be officially unveiling this plate series in conjunction with Veterans Day."

Combat Battle Star Plates can be ordered at any Deputy Registrar office or by mail. The applicant must submit a copy of his/her DD-214 displaying their participation in the designated campaign. These plates may also be ordered as reserved or personalized plates with additional applicable fees. For additional information call the Bureau of Motor Vehicles at 1-800-589-TAGS (1-800-589-8247).
