TRICARE FOR LIFE – NO INCREASES
Springfield, Virginia (5/6/09) – Bill Matz, President of the National Association for Uniformed Services[®] (NAUS), was called by White House staff assistant Matthew Flavin, and told that the President's 2010 Budget, just released, does not include any TRICARE fee increases.

ATTORNEY GENERAL PROPOSAL

The Ohio House and Senate voted to put service bonuses on the November 3, 2009 ballot. If it is approved by the voters, Veterans who served in Afghanistan, Iraq or the Persian Gulf would receive \$100 for each month of service - \$1,000 max. Veterans who served elsewhere during those conflicts would receive \$50 for each month - \$500 max. Family members of those killed in action would receive \$5,000 in addition to other allowable compensation.

PATRIOT PROGRAM-LEGAL SERVICES

Those on active duty full time including mobilized Guard and Reserve personnel and their families are provided free legal service including:

- Exercising rights under the Servicemembers Civil Relief Act.
- Drafting wills, including living wills.
- Power of Attorney, including for health care decisions.
