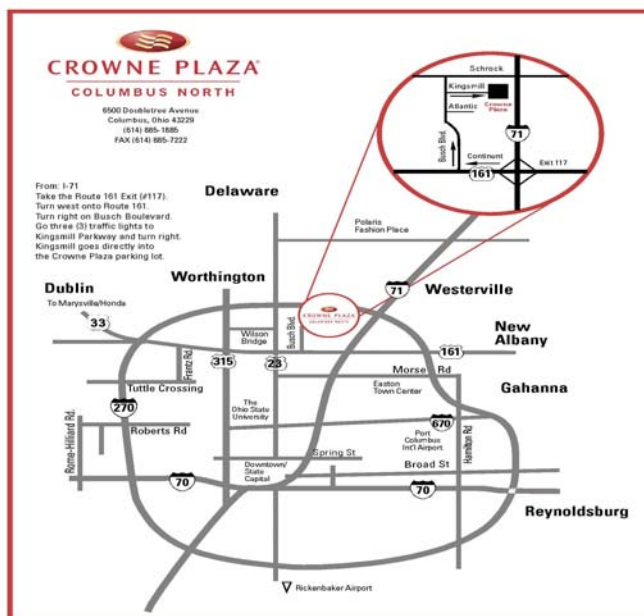

Peter Mansoor is the new Raymond E. Mason Jr. Chair in Military History, a joint appointment between the Mershon Center for International Security Studies and the Department of History at The Ohio State University. His research interests include modern U.S. military history, World War II, and counterinsurgency operations.

Before coming to OSU, he served as Executive Officer to Gen. David Petraeus, commander of the multinational forces in Iraq.

Banquet : Congressman Pat Tiberi

Congressman Pat Tiberi (TEE-berry), serving his fifth consecutive term representing the people of **Ohio's 12th District**, is on the powerful **Ways and Means Committee**. He chairs the Select Revenue Subcommittee and is a member of the Income Security and Family Support and Social Security Subcommittees. On October 17, 2006, the President signed legislation written by Congressman Tiberi, the **Older Americans Act Amendments**, into law. This crucial bill reauthorized and improved critical programs for our nation's seniors. His work on this legislation also earned praise from the American Association of Retired People (AARP), and the "Golden Meal" award from the Meals on Wheels Association of America. In an October 24, 2006 editorial the *Newark Advocate* called Tiberi "a compassionate, intelligent man who approaches issues from a balanced perspective not often found in today's partisan Congress...we think he stands out from every politician we interviewed this year."

Before coming to the U.S. House, Congressman Tiberi served in the Ohio House of Representatives (1993-2000) where he rose to the position of Majority Leader. Congressman Tiberi received a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Journalism in 1985 from The Ohio State University where he proudly played the trumpet in the OSU Marching Band. He's also been named a Watchdog of the Treasury for his efforts to protect taxpayers.
